DAILY SAFETY PROCEDURES



In accordance with the Maryland Department of Health and the Maryland State Department of Education, we have incorporated the following guidelines as recommended by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC).

VISITORS:

- Not allowed in the building

PARENTS:

- Parents/Guardians **MUST** wear personal protective equipment (PPE), specifically masks, when entering the facility and at all times while inside any portion of the facility.
- Parents/Guardians are not allowed in any of the classrooms.
- Contact between parents/guardians, staff, and other children is minimized at pick-up and drop-off.
- Parents must take their own child's temperature with the thermometer provided by the Center while remaining at the required distance. Teacher will accept child(ren) into the classroom if the temperature does not exceed 100.4.
- Symptom checks are being performed at arrival to include any possible COVID-19 symptoms in children and household members.

TEACHER:

- Teachers are to have their temperatures taken each morning prior to interacting with the children or other staff.
- Teachers must wear personal protective equipment (PPE), specifically masks, at all times while working at the facility.

OTHER SAFETY MEASURES IMPLEMENTED:

- Children are to wash their hands upon arrival and frequently throughout the day.
- We have increased our cleaning and disinfecting routine to multiple times per day with emphasis on cleaning and disinfecting frequently touched objects and surfaces
- Toys are not shared between groups of children. We are also cleaning and sanitizing toys multiple times during the day

GROUP DISTANCING:

- Our rooms are limited to no more than ten (10) people (including staff and children)
- When possible, staff and children are distant at least 6 feet apart
